Latex and Acrylic Paint is NOT Hazardous

Solidify by removing lid to allow paint to dry and dispose of the hardened paint with your regular trash

What NOT to Bring??????

- Ø Empty Containers/Trash/Electronic Waste/Appliances
- Ø Commercial or Industrial Waste
- Ø Radioactive Waste, Smoke Detectors
- Ø Infectious & Biological Wastes
- Ø Ammunition, Fireworks, Explosives
- Ø Fire Extinguishers
- Ø Syringes/Prescriptions
- Ø Organic Peroxides
- Ø Propane Tanks
- Ø Latex or Acrylic Paints (NOT Hazardous)

How Can I Safely Transport Hazardous Materials???

- Leave materials in original containers.
- Tighten Caps and lids.
- Sort and pack separately: oil paint, pesticides, and household cleaners.
- Pack containers in sturdy upright boxes and pad with newspaper.
- NEVER MIX CHEMICALS.
- NEVER SMOKE while handling hazardous material
