The Executive Session (es) was part of the Wenham Board of Selectmen (BOS) **November 13, 2018** posted meeting. Materials used in the preparation of such minutes and all documents and exhibits used at the session, may be withheld from disclosure to the public in their entirety under sub clause (a) of clause Twenty-sixth of Section 7 of Chapter 4, as long as publication may defeat the lawful purposes of the es, but no longer; provided, however, that the es was held in compliance with Section 21. Mr. Lombardi gave a brief overview of the proposed Side Letter to the AFSME Contract.

During collective bargaining for the FY17-19 AFSME contract the Town and AFSME Union agreed the Town would purchase and provide two new cell phones specifically to be used by the DPW employees assigned to standby for sanding/plowing duties.

The Union expressed interest returning to the practice of being directly contacted by Regional Dispatch on their personal phones. This would take effect on November 1. Dispatch has agreed to call the numbers as provided by the DPW.

The Selectmen agreed with the proposed amendment.

The Selectmen voted unanimously by roll call to return to open session at 6:01 pm
