This is Town Administrator Anthony Ansaldi.

I am reaching out to provide an update on some upcoming events and current protocols as we continue to respond to the COVID-19 pandemic.

First, Town Meeting has been rescheduled to Saturday, July 11 at an outdoor venue. The location and time will be determined and announced soon. The Warrant Book will be available online on June 17 and hardcopies will be mailed to all households.

The Finance Committee will host a budget forum on Wednesday June 17 at 6:30 pm on Zoom. It will be available on HWCAM for viewing multiple times before Town Meeting.

The Annual Election will be held on June 25 at Buker School. Call the Town Clerk to request Vote by Mail ballots or for details on safety protocols.

Please be aware that the parking lot and beach at Pleasant Pond remain closed. No gatekeepers or lifeguards are on duty. Fishing is open, with face covering and physical distancing requirements in place.

Trails, athletic fields, parks, and tennis courts are open. Residents must follow the safety guidelines from the Board of Health. Playground equipment and basketball courts remain closed. We will

continue to update the website with new guidance from the Board of Health.

As we head into summer some may consider out of state travel. We encourage residents to check with out-of-state destinations for any quarantine or testing requirements for MA residents. The Governor is still advising travelers arriving to MA to self-quarantine for 14 days upon arrival.

A reminder that all residents are “Safer at home.” We recognize that the safer at home advisories and closures of public facilities have been a challenge. We want to provide support and opportunities for engagement in civic life while balancing the public health of our community. We hope you can participate in the upcoming budget forum, town election, and town meeting in ways that you feel comfortable and we are working to ensure a safe and successful town meeting for all.
